We need to hear from both the buyer and seller at least a week before the change of service to ensure a smooth transfer of electricity. The same is true for renters - we need to hear from those moving out and those moving in.

If we don't hear from both parties, this may cause a slight delay in the transfer of service.

A deposit or prepaid meter may be required. Failure to complete a membership application may temporarily interrupt service until the necessary paperwork is completed.


