TIPS FOR A SAFE HARVEST

1. Maintain at least a 10-foot distance from power lines when operating equipment like grain augers, elevators and other tall machinery.




- 2. Use a spotter to navigate safely around power lines and other electrical equipment.
- 3. Ensure all farm workers are trained on electrical safety procedures.
- 4. Regularly inspect all electrical equipment and machinery for signs of wear and damage.
- 5. **Keep first aid kits** and emergency contact numbers in an easily accessible location.
- 6. If your equipment makes contact with an energized or downed power line, contact us immediately by phone and remain inside the vehicle until the power line is de-energized. In case of smoke or fire, exit the cab by making a solid jump out of the cab, without touching it at the same time, and hop away to safety.

Always use a spotter when there is potential for equipment to encroach overhead power lines. A spotter's perspective provides a much broader vantage point than the view from a cab. If your equipment brushes or contacts a power line or pole, stay in the cab and call 9-1-1.
